Students ages 10 & up are invited to enter a poster competition to win prizes in these categories:

A) Story Illustration:

Illustrate a scene or multiple scenes depicting an event or story from Mahavir Bhagwan's life. Provide a caption explaining the illustration.

B) Temple Exploration:

Create a colorful and eye-catching display poster explaining and illustrating an aspect of temples: behavior, parts, structure, idols, etc. Include terminology and examples.

Ideas for topics may be obtained from your pathshala teacher.

Students may enter in either or both categories, using full size or half size poster board. (Commonly available at many discount, drug, or office supply stores)

Students ages 9 & under are invited to enter a coloring contest.

C) Coloring: Color in pre-drawn sketches (available at the derasar) or draw and color a scene depicting an event in Mahavir Bhagwan's life using an 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper.

- Please do not write your name anywhere on the poster/sheet itself.
- Entries will be grouped by age and category.
- Judging will be anonymous & based upon both content and artistic value.
- Prizes awarded to top entries based upon age & category.
- All students will receive a certificate of participation.
